

AN ORDINANCE

BY THE POLICE COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR PERSONS OF ONE SEX TO IMPERSONATE, MASQUERADE OR DISGUISE THEMSELVES AS BEING OF ANOTHER SEX TO AID IN THE COMMISSION OF UNLAWFUL ACTS.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN of the City of Atlanta that the 1965 Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The intent and purpose of this ordinance is to prevent the use of a disguise in the form of clothing and apparel of the opposite sex in order to facilitate the commission of unlawful acts by persons using said disguise.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for persons to impersonate, masquerade or be disguised as being of the opposite sex where such impersonation, masquerade or disguise is assumed for the purpose of concealing said persons' true sex and deceiving others as to their true sex for the purpose of aiding or facilitating the commission of the following acts:

(a) The frequenting of any place which persons would not frequent if they were not impersonating, masquerading or disguising themselves as members of the opposite sex;

(b) Associating with any person or persons who would not willingly associate with them if they were not impersonating, masquerading or disguising themselves as members of the opposite sex;

(c) Any act now prohibited by federal, state, local

laws or ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances  
in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
